- book of abstract and certificate of participation
- refreshments during coffee breaks
- social event and sightseeing tour

Travel expenses will not be reimbursed.

After the conference, you will be invited to submit your paper for publication in a thematic issue of our Department's student journal, <u>Patchwork</u><sup>3</sup>. An e-mail with paper submission guidelines will be sent after the conference.
